I. Coworkers for God's glory (1:26-27)

- A. Significant phrase "image bearers, male and female"
- B. Implications for marriage.
 - Equal but different roles—we are different by design. "Form fits function"

II. Children for God's glory (1:28)

- A. Significant phrase "fill the earth" with more image bearers
- B. Implications for marriage.

III. Completer for God's glory (2:18)

- A. Significant phrase— "helper suitable"
- B. Implications for marriage
 - Role confusion causes a lot of conflict in marriage just like it does in any relationship.

IV. Companionship for God's glory (2:18)

- A. Significant phrases, "not good for man to be alone;" "Bone of my bone, flesh of my flesh;" "naked and not ashamed."
- B. Implications for marriage

V. Covenant Relationship for God's glory (2:22-23; cf. also Ephesians 5: 31-32)

- A. Significant phrase "this is now bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh"
 - Covenant = "a sacred commitment to live in sealed allegiance to one another for life."
 - B. Implications for marriage

VI. Caution! The fall distorts everything. (Genesis 3)

A. Significant phrases---(3:6-12; 17)

The heart (mind, will, affections, emotions) becomes corrupted because of giving into wrong desires.

B. Implications for marriage
